

Dear colleagues,

following our information from last evening (applicable from 15.01.2021):

- please find enclosed a draft online registration form for pax approaching Austria which pax should file online before arrival from
- airlines are kindly asked to inform pax about the need to file online registration at <https://www.sozialministerium.at/PTC-Form-en>
- airlines are kindly asked to distribute paperform of form to pax approaching Austria and not having filed the electronic version and to ask pax to fill in during flight already to avoid jams at the airports upon arrival

So, to summarize, on board of the aircraft only one form needs to be distributed any more in case if pax has not filed electronic version before the flight.

Furthermore, to summarize NOTAMs:

- landing bans for UK and RSA are still valid till 24.01.2021 24:00
- on board of aircraft community masks have to be worn
- airlines are requested to collect data of pax (full name, DOB, nationality, place of departure, departure and arrival date and time, airport, number of pax carried, flight number) - most of these information normally is already available at airlines
