Subject: Update – Entrance and exit limitation to and from Israel

The following is an abstract of the Ministry of Health and the Prime Minister's Office's notice regarding updating the limitations of entry and exit to Israel starting on 3.5.2021 until 16.5.2021.

+ Entry to Israel:

- Every entering passenger into Israel, **including vaccinated passengers and recovering from covid-19 passengers**, from the following countries:

Ukraine

Ethiopia

Brazil

South Africa

India

Mexico

Turkey

Is obligated to isolation for 14 days or 10 days subject to two negative covid-19 tests.

+ Exit from Israel:

- Exit of Israeli citizens (excluding exceptions) to the above-listed countries is forbidden.
 - Non-Israeli citizens will be able to fly to those countries only to exit for a permanent place of residence.
 - It shall be emphasized that the prohibition to those countries will not apply to persons staying in the airport area of that country for a period of up to 12 hours after landing (connection flights).
- + An establishment of the Exceptions Committee headed by an employee of Population Authority, and the Attainment Committee, headed by an employee of the Ministry of Health will deliberate on the exception requests.**
